<b>Description</b>	<p>Alphabetical and special characters are accepted in the amount field and no error message is displayed.</p> <p><b>How to recreate:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Fill in alphabetical and special characters (200convert%) and <b>OBSERVE</b> that no error message is displayed.</li></ol>

<b>Summary</b>	The dates displayed under the USD-EUR chart are not accurate
<b>Category</b>	<b>Problem</b>
<b>Severity</b>	<b>Normal</b>
<b>Description</b>	<p>The period displayed under the chart is not accurate when selecting 1Y, 2Y, 5Y, and 10Y options. When 10Y is selected the dates displayed under the chart are Feb 10, 2014, 00:00 UTC – Feb 7, 2024, 16:44 UTC. This issue can mislead users by providing incorrect historical data ranges.</p> <p><b>How to recreate:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Click on the Charts tab.</li> <li>2. Select a pair of currencies and click the View Chart button.</li> <li>3. Click on the 10Y (or 1Y, 2Y, 5Y) and <b>OBSERVE</b> that the displayed period is not accurate.</li> </ol>



<b>Description</b>	<p>The application crashes when selecting a currency pair displayed under the Live Currency Rates in the Charts tab.</p> <p><b>How to recreate:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Click on the Charts tab.</li> <li>2. <b>Description</b>	<p>When entering an amount (ex: 500) in the Amount field, and clicking on the home icon or going to another part of the website, the amount entered previously remains in the amount field.</p> <p><b>How to recreate:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Fill in the amount field (500).</li> <li>2. Select the currency pairs (USD-EUR).</li> <li>3. Click on the Convert button.</li> <li>4. Click on the XE home page icon and <b>OBSERVE</b> that the input in the amount field is not updated.</li> </ol>

<b>Summary</b>	The 24H chart redirects the user to a 1Y chart
<b>Category</b>	<b>Problem</b>
<b>Severity</b>	<b>Normal</b>
<b>Description</b>	<p>The user is redirected to the 1-Year chart when accessing the 24H chart, from the Xe Live Exchange Rates table. This incorrect redirection leads to user confusion.</p> <p><b>How to recreate:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. On the homepage, scroll down to Xe Live Exchange Rates.</li> <li>2. Click on the chart image under Chart (24h) and <b>OBSERVE</b> that you are redirected to the 1Y chart.</li> </ol>

<b>Summary</b>	The drop-down list from Resources and Tools stays on the screen after selecting an option
<b>Category</b>	<b>Problem</b>
<b>Severity</b>	<b>Normal</b>
<b>Description</b>	<p>The drop-down list from Resources and Tools stays on the screen after selecting an option (Historical Currency Rates, IBAN Calculator, Apps, Refer A Friend, etc.). This obstructs part of the page.</p> <p><b>How to recreate:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Click on the Tools tab.</li> <li>2. Select Apps or Historical Currency Rates and <b>OBSERVE</b> that the drop-down list stays on the page after selecting the option.</li> </ol>

<b>Category</b>	<b>Problem</b>
<b>Severity</b>	<b>Normal</b>
<b>Description</b>	<p>The description of January 1995 from the “About us” section appears twice. This looks weird.</p> <p><b>How to recreate:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Select “About us” from the bottom of the page.</li> <li>2. Scroll down on the page till you arrive at Our History and <b>OBSERVE</b> that the description of January 1995 is duplicated.</li> </ol>

<b>Summary</b>	When searching for a currency by the first three letters, other currencies that don't contain those first three letters are also displayed
<b>Category</b>	<b>Problem</b>
<b>Severity</b>	<b>Normal</b>
<b>Description</b>	<p>When performing a search for a currency by entering the first three letters, the search results include other currencies that do not contain the specified three-letter sequence. This behavior is incorrect as it should only display currencies that match the entered criteria.</p> <p><b>How to recreate:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Go to the Convert tab.</li> <li>2. In the From field type "ind" and <b>OBSERVE</b> that the drop-down list also displays currencies that don't contain those letters in the same order.</li> </ol>
